A session on E- waste management was organised by the NSS Unit of College Of Home Science Nirmala Niketan on 16th of August 2019 at which Ms. Rashmi Joshi the speaker of the program talked about E- waste management as well as included Solid Waste management

and Compost pit in her talk. The program started at 02:00 pm with Dr. Pratima Goyal introduced the speaker Ms. Rashmi Joshi.

She first introduced the ill effects of E-waste especially directing our attention to the main effect of waste- Cancer. She mentioned that "around 10 years ago the ratio of cancer was 1 out of 10 person but today the scenario has changed drastically" adding to it that "In today's time out of 10 9 of the people were diagnosed with cancer". She also talked about ban on plastic listing its effects on mankind and the environment.

As she proceed further she also explain how to manage the day- to- day waste collected in one's home. She also mentioned about the initiative taken by the BMC Department of ways of motivating the society by giving concession on property tax to the society members on segregating the waste or using the segregated waste to build a compost pit.

She continued her speech with introducing E- waste and the dangerous pollutants in the environment which then leads to spread of diseases like cancer, Respiratory diseases, skin diseases, etc. She also explained the process how E- waste like refrigerator, television, air conditioner, etc is treated after we give away. She ended her speech with suggesting an idea of a demonstration of compost pit and also appreciated the initiative taken by the NSS Unit to generate E- waste from their houses. Experts from specialized fields had come to enlighten us with their knowledge, better our understanding and spread awareness. Rtn. Jhankar Gadkari was the moderator of the panel discussion. Dr. Satya Agarwal, our first speaker, spoke about Organ donation, when can a person donate their organs and what organs could be donated. He spoke about brain death and the difference between organ donation and tissue donation. He spoke about skin as a "band-aid" And how anybody could donate their skin/tissue to anyone. He removed the concerns regarding defiling or defacing explaining to us in depth the process after the skin is donated. Dr. Girish Trivedi, our eye expert, spoke about how one person can donate their eye and save two corneally blind people. He showed us the statistics that if each dead person donated their eyes, our nation would become blind free in just 11 days. All in all the session concluded with sensitizing people about the need of organ donation

The event was conducted by Tata Memorial Hospital & Actrec Transplant Center. The doctors visited the college for 2 days spreading awareness about the donation and held up a camp on 14th January 2020.

Any volunteer donor between the age of 18-50 years and above 50kgs weight can donate. After having counselled satisfactorily on 13th January 2020, registry process was a simple matter of filing up a registration form, giving a small blood sample (only 6ml) and answering a few questions about your health. After donation, the Marrow Donor Registry India (MDRI) will recruit and try to match volunteer stem cell donors from its database with patients, arrange donor stem cell collection and immediate transportation to the patient's transplant center. There will be a variable period of time before the donors would be contacted again.

Volunteers helped encouraging people to donate blood, filling the donor forms and by making announcements. Everyone participated enthusiastically and faced no problems during the service. The volunteers were been provided

with breakfast, lunch and snacks also. The purpose of this camp was to donate and collect blood for the cancer stricken children, for people facing other diseases



and mainly for the victims of the incident at. A senior doctor of Nair Hospital was in charge of the event. Instructions were given beforehand to the volunteers, which were been followed correctly. Volunteers campaigned with posters and boards and were able to convince many citizens for donation. 45 units of blood was donated in the morning batch till 1pm. 35 donors were rejected on medical grounds and 150 donors donated blood. Efforts of both the groups were pooled in to achieve 113 units of blood getting donated.
