About the Event:

An Awareness Session on Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) was organized by Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), College of Home Science, Nirmala Niketan (Affiliated to University of Mumbai) in collaboration with Office of Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trademarks, Mumbai Under National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM), Government of India under the banner of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" to commemorate the 75th Anniversary of India's Independence.

This session was organized to sensitize the students, teachers and other stakeholders about the role of IPR in innovation and invention. It was attended by undergraduate, post graduate students, Ph.D. scholars and teaching faculty from various departments.

The program began with the welcome address by Dr. Anuradha J Bakshi (I/C Principal). This was followed by the introduction to the Resource Person by Dr. Minelly Rodrigues.

The Resource person was Mrs. Ujjwal Singh, Examiner of Patents and Designs, Mumbai Patents Office, Department of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India. She exposed the participants to different types of Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) such as patents, design, geographic indication, copyrights and trademarks. She gave relevant examples from the field of Home Science which helped participants relate to the concept in an effective way. The participants were also shown animated videos on IPR developed by the Government of India. A mini quiz on different forms of IPR was also a part of the session. She also shared information on databases for search of patent related information such as WIPO.

The session was followed by a question and answer session. Various questions were asked on different aspects of IPR such as the application process for patent, Geographic indication and ownership etc. by both staff and students.

The feedback link for the session was shared with the participants towards the end of the program. The session was highly appreciated by all participants.

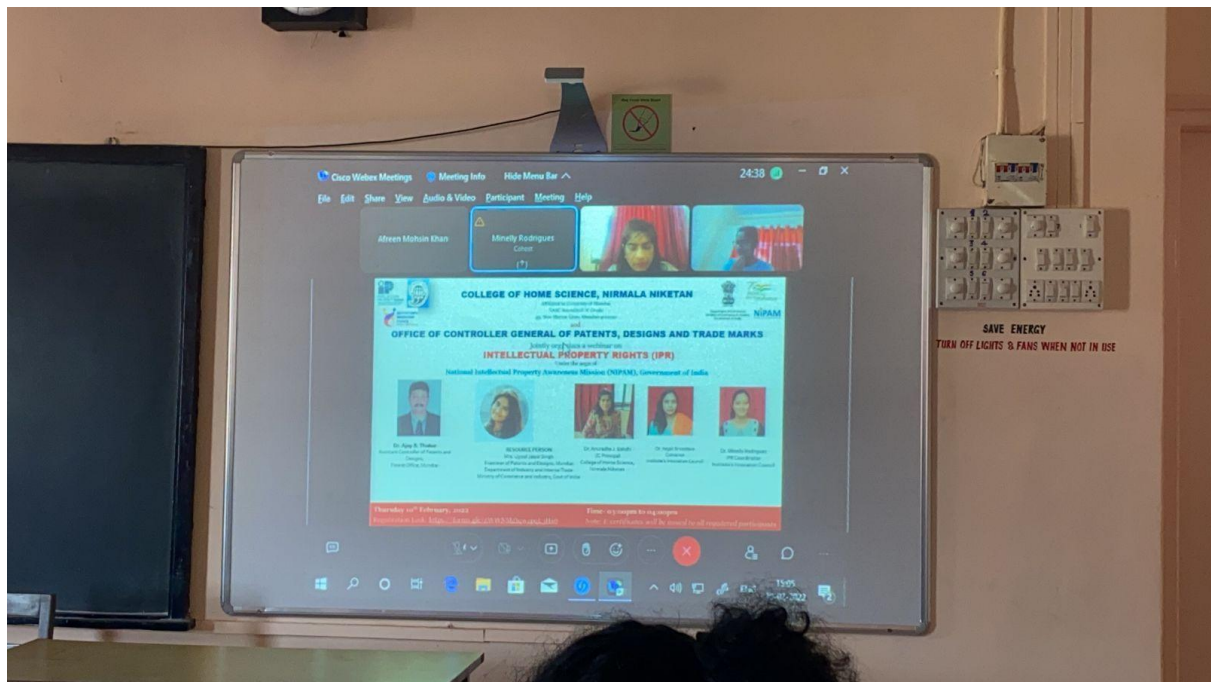

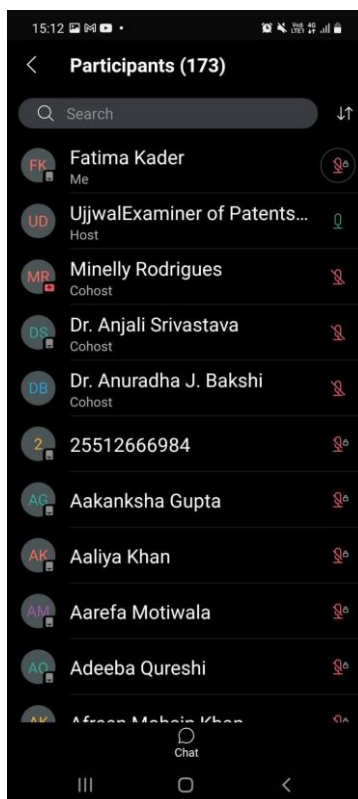
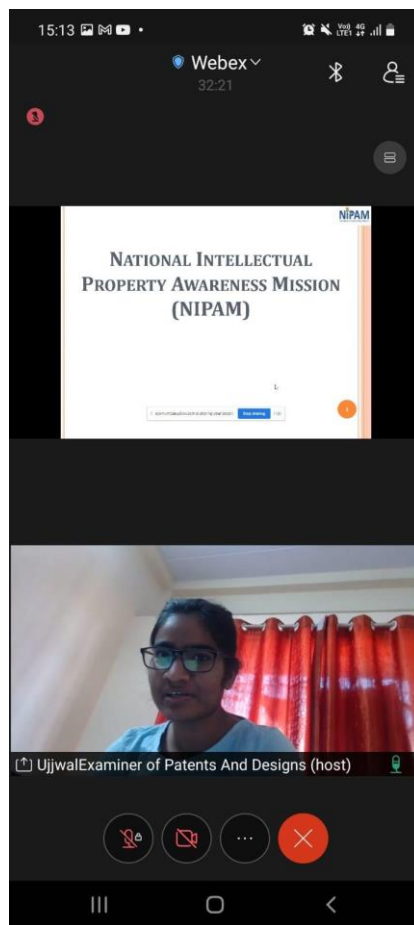
