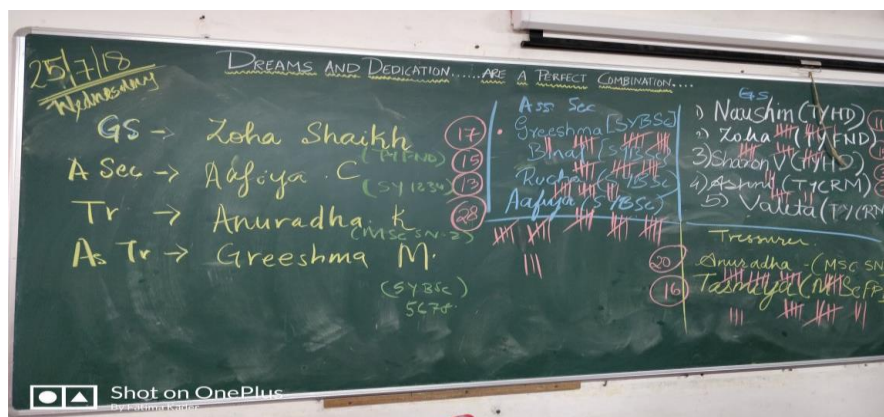


STUDENT COUNCIL REPORT FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-2019
