Eligibility

•Any student from **First Year or Second Year Degree College who is currently a bonafide undergraduate student from any University** is eligible to compete. Work must be done in group (maximum 5 students) or individually by the student/s.

Objectives of Intercollegiate Interdisciplinary Undergraduate Research Competition

To provide:

- the opportunity to share their research ideas and results at a special forum that provides visibility for their work
- a platform to interact with attendees to share ideas, gain new insights, and understand possible practical applications
- constructive feedback about their research and presentation, from a panel of distinguished judges from industry and academia
- recognize and reward outstanding student research

Winning research group/student will receive trophy, certificate and cash prize

- 1. First prize Rs. 5000/- cash prize and trophy
- 2. Second prize Rs. 3000/- cash prize and trophy
- 3. Third Prize Rs. 2000/- cash prize and trophy

All students will receive a participation certificate

RULES FOR PARTICIPATING FOR AARYA

- Any student from **First Year or Second Year Degree College** who is currently a **bonafide undergraduate student from any University** is eligible to compete.
- Student should have **valid identity card** of the College / Recognized Institute / Department from where he / she is pursuing his / her degree / diploma.
- Students can present their research project in group with maximum number of students **not exceeding five** (<u>only two students will be allowed to present on the final day of the competition</u>).
- Student can present their research project work in English or Hindi language.
- Ethics of research must be delicately observed by students and his / her mentor.

Criteria For Judging

- Novelty & Uniqueness of Research Topic
- Content Process (Rationale & Purpose, review of literature, objective/s, methodology, result and discussion)
- Interdisciplinary approach
- Relevance to current situation /application of the research / Significance/contribution of the research to society
- Presentation skills (Visual and Oral presentation)
- Ability to answer queries/ questions
- Overall impact
