The organizations that participated were provided a LCD **Projector**, screen, mikes and audio speakers will be provided for a 40 minute presentation and discussion slot, wherein the organizations had to present their company and job profile to the prospective employees. They were free to distribute recruitment forms, pamphlets and feedback or opinion forms within the given time slot.

Companies from varied fields participated in the two day 'Career Fair 2016" held on 16th and 17th March, 2016 was arranged for T.Y.B.Sc. Foods, Nutrition and Dietetics- Semester VI; M.Sc.
