The purpose of this event was to help students prepare their resume; connect the employer, with potential employees. We also wanted to expose our students to the many employment opportunities and professional ethics to be followed.

**STUDENT ENROLLMENT:** It was decided that the current (T.Y. & M.Sc.–II) students would have to pay an enrolment fee of Rs. 50/.

**CAMPUS INTERVEIWS 2017-2018-** The Employment Placement Cell organised "Career Fair 2018 — Exploring Employment Opportunities".

Invite letters to companies/corporate/schools were mailed. Several companies' institutes and NGOs confirmed. Concerned representative's personally contacted authorities in the companies/schools. The organizations that participated were provided a LCD **Projector**, screen, mikes and audio speakers will be provided for a 40 minute presentation and discussion slot, wherein the organizations had to present their company and job profile to the prospective employees. They were free to distribute recruitment forms, pamphlets and feedback or opinion forms within the given time slot.

Companies from varied fields participated in the two day 'Career Fair 2018" held on 17th and 19th March, 2018 was arranged for T.Y.B.Sc. Foods, Nutrition and Dietetics- Semester VI;

M.Sc. Foods, Nutrition and Dietetics-Semester IV; M.Sc. Food Processing and Preservation-Semester IV; M.Sc. Sports Nutrition-Semester IV and P.G.D. Dietetics and Applied Nutrition-Semester II. The purpose of this event was to connect, the employer, with potential employees—our students from graduate and post graduate cadre. It also helped us expose our students to the many employment opportunities available to them, both locally and nationally. Students were encouraged to bring their resumes to share with prospective employers. Interviews were arranged at the employer's premises at the convenience of the employer and the students. Participating companies were as follows: Core Fitness, Qua Nutrition, Gauri Murthy Academy, Balance Nutrition, Hexagon Nutrition, Qua Nutrition Bangalore, Eighty Twenty By Kajal Bhatia, True Elements and Freshtrop Fruits Ltd. Nashik.

The Department of Human Development had organised a Career Fair for the students of third year and master's degree of Human Development on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2018. The session started at 10.00am to 2.30pm. There were 8 Human Developmental Organisation namely Women India Trust (which could not make it for the session), New Horizon Institute, Muktangan, Jeevandeep Edu pvt, Kangaroo Kids and Billabong High International School, Angel Express Foundation, TIFR Child Care Centre and RTI Montessori Training Course had come for the fair to talk about their organisation and their required job openings. Each organisation had to pay a registration fee of Rs. 3,500 for the career fair. The EPC collected an amount of Rs. 28000 through this career fair. The required job openings were that as a preschool teacher, content developer, coordinator, teacher trainer, HR etc.

The Department of Textiles and Fashion Technology planned and Community Resource Management students were recruited through out house recruitment and through internship.

The 'Career Fair 2018" process was very smoothly executed as planned and the feedback was obtained in writing from most of the companies/corporate/schools. Several students have been selected by the companies for various posts as well as for the training programme before they are officially appointed on any specific post as per their recruitment training skills.
