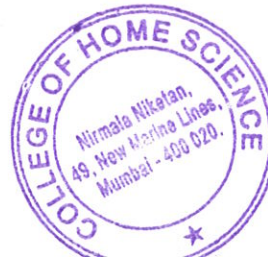

Please note:

1	Students to take note of the precise date, time and room for the examination given in the Timetable that is displayed on the notice board/website.

At 30 minutes before the examination, students must be seated as per the exam requirements, without any study material etc with them.

7	Students must wear the ID card and also carry your hall ticket daily.
8	Students specially challenged or with learning disability, under the category of Divyangjan, requiring a writer etc., should take prior permission and should carry the original certificate in order to avail of special provisions during the examinations.
