Post Covid, the committee wanted to bring new segments to the Nirmal Utsav. A three day fest was planned which included in-house (11th Jan 2023) and intercollegiate events (1st Feb 2023) and the Grand Finale of the event (2nd Feb 2023) in the form of cultural program in the Birla Matoshree Auditorium, Churchgate. 
I proudly conclude that this years' Nirmal Utsav AAGAAZ 23 has had many new beginnings:
