National Service Scheme Cell, University of Mumbai, My Green Society jointly organized an induction programme for NSS Volunteers from all over Mumbai on 4th August, 2022 at Meera Watumull Auditorium, R. D. National College, Bandra (W).

As few of us know that, "International Coastal Cleanup Day" is celebrated on third saturday of September. On 17th September, 2022, a mega cleanliness campaign is being organized. Under the aegis of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav".

The "Clean Coast Safe Seas" campaign will cover the entire coastline of 7500 km in 75 coastal districts at 75 main sea coasts with 75 volunteers at every kilometres of the coastline. This campaign is focused on minimal use of single used plastic and source segregation at every household in the country.

The member of AIPMA told us more about the plastics and their effects on environment. He asked a very simple question to all the volunteers out there, 'Is plastic good for environment?'and very precisely everyone said "No". After that he told us as a product plastic is one of the best invention by humans. It is cheaper, takes very less time to manufacture, easy to carry and even easy to use. But the point is that after being so human friendly why plastic is called hazardous for us. This is all because of the improper segregation of those plastic products. He also give us some ideas how we can reuse plastic products.

BMC members were also there to motivate us to segregate plastic waste properly and make our place and environment healthy for each and everyone. The role of Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation is to maintain sanitation and health; in this connection it manages hospitals, garbage collection and disposal, the sewerage, and the water supply. As part of its duties related to public health, it is responsible for the prevention of epidemics. BMC is doing a great job with respect to plastic segregation. They segregated and treat the plastic waste properly and make our surrounding areas healthy place for us to survive in.

Later on the Indian Coast Guard Commander and deputy Commander, Ravi Kumar and Prasoon kr. Tiwari shared their thoughts with our volunteers. They told us about the Coast Guard. They told us about following topics:-




