There were several Events/Activities organised by the Student Council during this academic year:

1) The **Facility Tours of the College** were conducted this year, for ALL class groups on account of 2 years Pandemic and consequently online classes. The tours were conducted by all the SC staff and began on 22nd June onwards, till all FY groups entered college.
