6. VALUE ADDED COURSES OF THE DEPARTMENT:

The SEEDS Arts-Based Therapy (ABT) one-year Diploma Programme of the department, under the outstanding leadership of ABT-practitioner and educator, Ms. Zill Botadkar, is an outcome of the MoU between the college and Lighthouse. The programme was ongoing this year, extended from last academic year because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Of the 21 students in the programme, 19 graduated by the end of this academic year.
