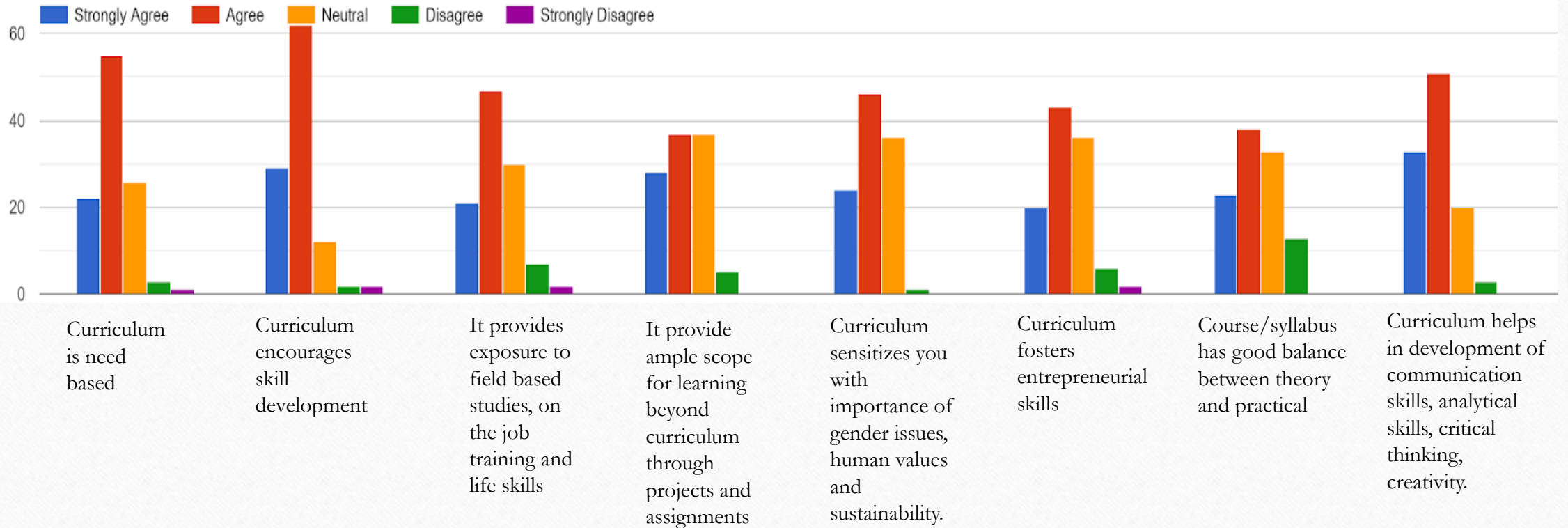

Analysis of parameters

- Curriculum is need based
 - 20% students strongly agree and 51% students agree
- Curriculum encourages skill development
 - 27% students strongly agree and 58% students agree
- It provides exposure to field based studies, on the job training and life skills
 - 20% students strongly agree and 44% students agree, where as 6% students disagree
- It provide ample scope for learning beyond curriculum through projects and assignments
 - 26% students strongly agree and 35% students agree, whereas 35% students are neutral

Analysis of parameters

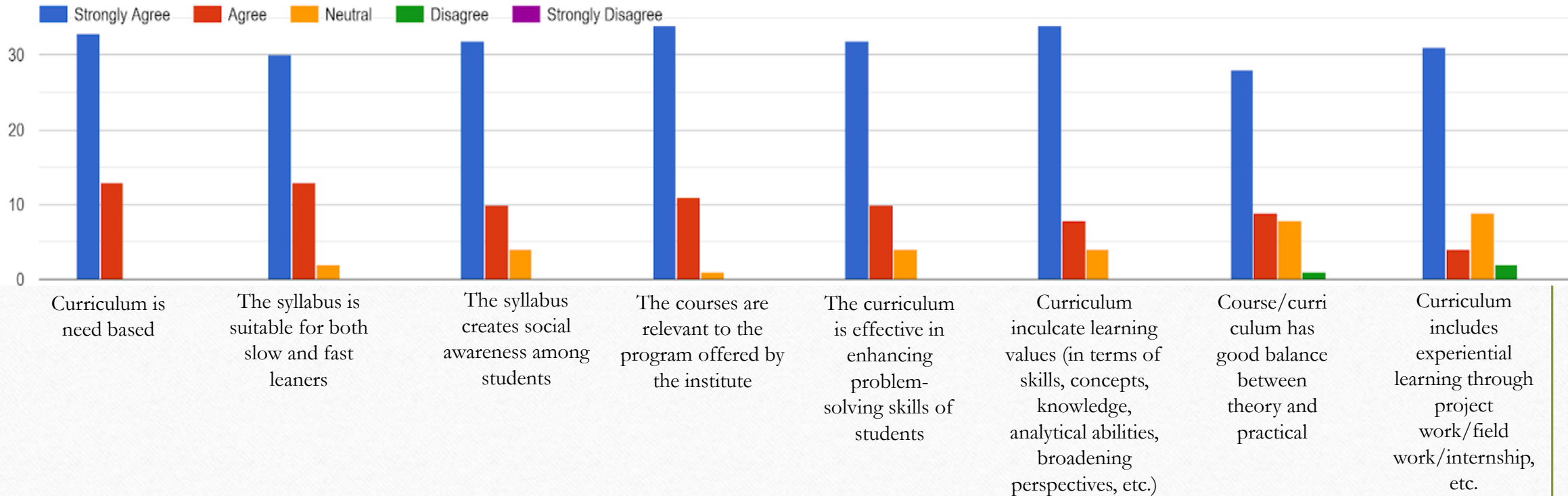
- Curriculum sensitizes you with importance of gender issues, human values and sustainability

Analysis of parameters

 - 71% teachers strongly agree and 28% teachers agree

 - 65% teachers strongly agree and 28% teachers agree
- The syllabus creates social awareness among students
 - 69% teachers strongly agree and 22% teachers agree, where as 8% teachers disagree
- The courses are relevant to the program offered by the institute
 - 74% teachers strongly agree and 24% teachers agree

Analysis of parameters

- The curriculum is effective in enhancing problem-solving skills of students
 - 69% teachers strongly agree and 22% teachers agree, whereas 8% teachers are neutral
- Curriculum inculcate learning values (in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities, broadening perspectives, etc.)
 - 74% teachers strongly agree and 17% teachers agree, whereas 8% teachers are neutral

 - 67% teachers strongly agree and 8% teachers agree, whereas 4% teachers disagree

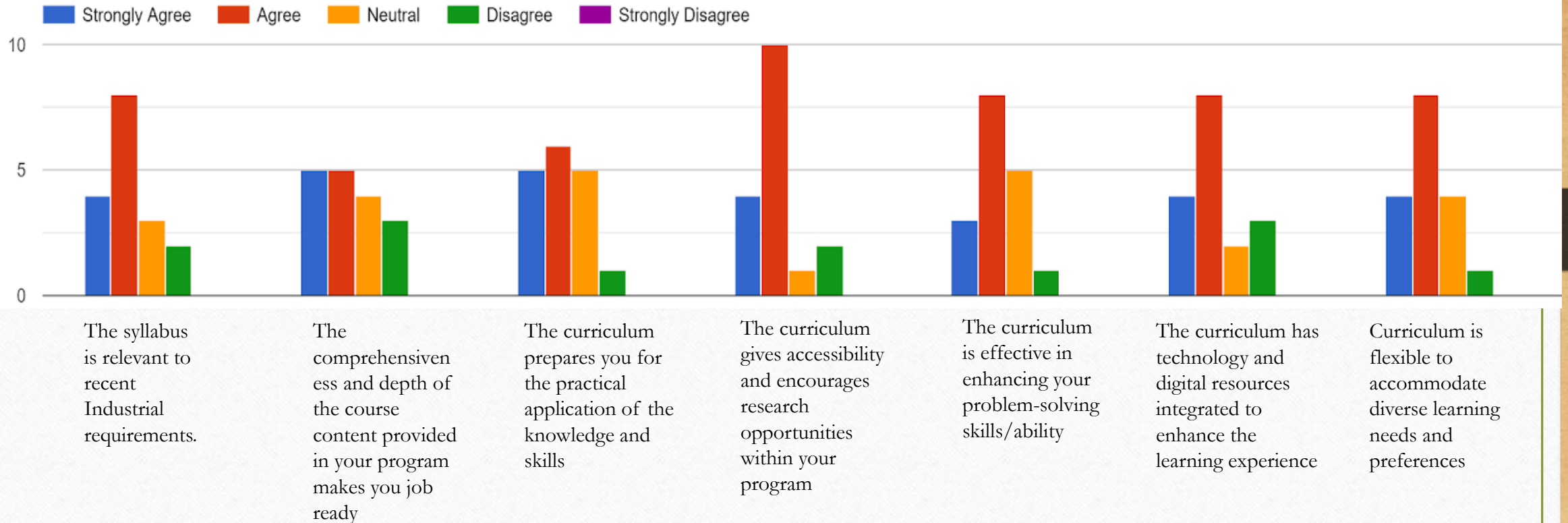
