



➤ About the Event (Event Flow, if available): Upon visiting Chuim Community Center we learnt that this is not an orphanage but a place where low income parents of the area keep their children when they are at work. The sister in charge told us about how before parents would give their children cough medicine to put them to sleep so that the parents could go to work. Parents would also discourage the children from studying and would keep them at home. The community center looks after infants past 6 months to about 4 years old. There are rules to be followed for the child to be admitted. The child must be washed, clothes ironed and clean shoes. The parents can do these things in the community center as well only then are they allowed inside. If any child complains of issues at home the parents are called and the child is not allowed to attend classes till the parents come for a counseling session. The Community center also has computer classes and stitching classes. The children are provided with breakfast, milk, nutrient packed ladoos, and lunch by afternoon parents must pick the child up. The infant and toddlers are kept on the ground floor and the bigger children are on the first floor. There is also a doctor who comes to check on the children when required.

➤ About the Event: We started the event with an introduction of NSS, its aims and objectives. We took an oath as NSS volunteers and decided to go the extra mile and were introduced to all the teachers who are a part of NSS in our college. They told us about the benefit of joining NSS, that it gives us a taste of the real world, which only being in a classroom can never teach you. Our Guest of honor Ms. Rashmi is not only a plant enthusiast but also a kind generous person who donated 100 indoor plant saplings for all our volunteers. The plants brought were high oxygen producing plants that improve the quality of the air in the house. She also taught us seed ball making. She told us when we eat any fruit, the seeds should be placed in water for a while so that any residue comes off. We then have to completely dry the seed for a few days. After doing this we should take some mud and compost/natural manure and make a dough consistency. Place 1 seed in a little mud ball, close it and keep it dry for a while. The purpose of this is it protects the seed and increase the shelf life of the seed when planted. It also provides the seed with nutrients.

About the event:

We started the day with yoga conducted by one of our NSS volunteers and learned how to do Surya namaskar. We then left for the dam building activity in the nearby area at Manpada. Since it was the occasion of Makar Sankranti we went and came from the village walking in the sun so the rays could get absorbed and help store vitamin D for a long time in our bodies. To build the Vanrai Bandhara we had to fill sacs with mud and stones and tie them up. We then place them in two parallel lines across the lake to restrict the water flow. We then packed mud between the parallel lines to ensure the water doesn't flow through and a proper Vanrai Bandhara is formed. Mr. Dayanand from Manpada told us about the several benefits of building the Vanrai Bandhara like: - the collected water can be used to wash clothes, utensils etc -can be used by the cattle of the area -it will get relocated, pass through the ground and fill the nearby wells -the collected water will remain there for some time -the activity helped us to learn how to build a Vanrai Bandhara. After this activity we went to the nearby village of Brahmanpada. We had prepared Channa chaat which is rich in proteins, vitamin B12, and a Tamarind and Jaggery water for the village people of the local area. We donated some clothes and stationery and

served what we prepared. We also performed our social awareness skits for the villagers. Upon returning we discussed our action plan for the next day, contemplating all the lessons that were learnt that day. And ended it with report writing

Upon returning to Gyan Jyoti we bought some of the things that the local girls had made.


