

Scholarship report 2023-24

The new academic year began by the orienting students from the FYBSc to MSc levels about the various scholarships available at the National, State, University and College level. Students were also informed about other religious, private trust and company scholarships. Regular announcements and messages were sent to remind students to apply for scholarship and keep them abreast of the dates for application.

Below are the details of the various types of scholarships availed by the students:

Details of College Level Need-based Scholarship

Applications were invited for college level scholarships, and these applicants were then interviewed to know out more about their need. The students were paid from the interest earned from fixed deposits for scholarships that were instituted by individuals and trusts through the years and also an additional amount collected through a special donation drive initiated by the Scholarship Committee for the year 2020-21 due to the pandemic.

- 5 students received the scholarships
- An amount of Rs. 27,000/- was availed by the students.

Details of Scholarship Applications at the Government level (National and State)

A total of 18 students applied for these scholarships:

Details are as under:

- National level scholarship:
 - 1 student applied and received scholarship under category of Post Matric Scholarship for ST students-State of Manipur.
- State level scholarships:
 - A total of 17 students have applied for the following scholarships.
 - 2 students have applied for the Government of India Post Matric Scholarship under the Social Justice and Special Assistance Department.
 - 5 students have applied for scholarship through OBC, SEBC, VJNT & SBC Welfare Department.
 - 10 students from the Open category have applied the Rajashri Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulk Shishyavrutti Scheme under the Directorate of Higher Education.

Details of Scholarship amount received from the State Government level:

A total of 71 students received the scholarship amount totaling to Rs. 5,25,756.30.

The following are the details of the scholarships received by the students in the financial year 2023-24 (students have applied in the academic year 2023-24 as well as earlier academic years)

- 2 students received a total of Rs. 20,056.80 for the Government of India Post-Matric Scholarship scheme under Social Justice and Special Assistance Department.

- 2 students received Rs 6,068.00 for Post Matric Scholarship to SBC Students scheme under OBC, SEBC, VJNT & SBC Welfare Department
- 1 student received Rs. 14,957.00 for Post Matric Scholarship to VJNT Students under the OBC, SEBC, VJNT & SBC Welfare Department
- 4 students received a total of Rs. 56,408.00 for Tuition Fees and Examination Fees to OBC Students scheme under the OBC, SEBC, VJNT & SBC Welfare Department
- 3 students received a total of Rs 61,334.00 for Post Matric Scholarship Scheme under the Tribal Development Department.
- 2 students received Rs. 1000.00 under State Minority Scholarship under Department of Directorate of Higher Education.
- 45 students from the Open category received a total of Rs. 2,35,959.50 for the Rajashri Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulk Shishyavrutti Scheme under the Department of Directorate of Higher Education.
