There were several Events/Activities organised by the Student Council during this academic year:

- 1) **Facility Tours of the College** were conducted this year for new FY groups as part of the Student Induction Programme (SIP) for new students to be made aware of college facilities and their locations. The tours were conducted by all the SC staff and began from June onwards, till all FY groups entered college.


