**RULES OF THE EVENT**

- Each team should consist of ONE writer and ONE artist.
- Each team of Artist and Writer will be given 1 hour to complete their work
- Artists should refrain from incorporating any text or written content in their artwork. The writers aim to derive inspiration solely from the visual elements.
- Submissions should be anonymous to ensure impartial judging. Each team will be assigned a unique code, and all submissions should be labeled accordingly.
- Writers can choose to create either a poetry or essay piece based on the artwork.
- Both the artwork and the written piece must be original works created specifically for the competition. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.
