

The process involves spinning, dyeing, and weaving. First, the fibers are spun into yarn using a hand-operated spinning wheel. The yarn is dyed using natural dyes such as indigo, turmeric, and pomegranate. Weavers then create intricate designs using a handloom and techniques such as different colors, textures, and thicknesses of yarn. Bhujodi weaving uses Kala cotton, which is grown in the Kutch region and is eco-friendly and naturally resistant to pests and diseases. The final products include shawls, blankets, and sarees.

The first visit of the day was to the National Incubation Centre. Dr. Deepika acknowledged us about how different natural colours were made and about the raw materials used for the same. Along with these natural dyes, there were also products made from Teracota. We had our hands on the Teracota Ganesha idol painting. Spray painting was done to have even painting over the idol. We also saw Eco Holi colours which was safe for our skin and also made the skin glow. Next, we went to the Weavers service centre. There we saw different types of loom set ups. There, ikat weaving was done, pochampalli to be more precise. Jacquard looms with needle punching jacquard cards were seen. Electronic jacquard was also there which does not need needle punches and actually saves time. Block printing with bigger blocks were seen.
