# General Rules





# Marks (M) (Points)

Participation points for participating in events and theme days will be based on percentage.

For eg: if 20% students of a class are participating in the respective event they will get 2M and if 90% class participate they get 9M for the respective.

For Participation of each student per event will get 5M for Intercollegiate events, Intracollegiate (InHouse) competitions, and participation in InterCollegiate competitions (Outside College) and Nirmal Utsav Show.

Eg- So if 3 students are participating in each 3 events they will

get:  $3 \times 5 \times 3 = 45$  points.

# Marks (M) (Points)

For volunteering, each volunteer will get 2M for every activity or event they volunteer.

CCR's will get 2M attendance for every meeting and activities they are present in.

Back out in any event of our college's or other colleges fest may lead to minus 5 marks for each person in every activity/competition. Except emergencies or any issues which shall be prior discussed.

At the end points will be calculated and the class with max points get the **BEST CLASS AWARD.**

- Topic will be given on 3rd February, 2025


