ADMISSION NOTICE for the MSc (HOME SCIENCE) PROGRAMME 2025-2026 FOODS, NUTRITION AND DIETETICS (AIDED)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

For being eligible for admission, a learner must have passed:

- B.Sc. Home Science with specialization in Foods, Nutrition and Dietetics or its equivalent. OR
- B.Sc. with Foods and Nutrition/ Foods, Nutrition and Dietetics/Food Technology or its equivalent.
 - OR
- B.Sc. General/Composite Home Science OR
- B.Sc. Home Science in any other Specialization OR
- B.Sc. Microbiology/Biochemistry/ Life Sciences/Chemistry/Biotechnology/Biological Sciences as a major or part fulfilment. OR
- B.Sc. Home Economics OR
- B.Sc. Human Ecology OR
- B.Sc. Family and Community Sciences OR
- B.Sc./ B.A. in Human Sciences OR
- B.Sc. Nursing or an equivalent Nursing Degree of another recognized University. OR
- B.Sc. Pharmacology OR
- B.Pt. (Bachelor of Physiotherapy) OR
- Medical Graduates in any discipline (MBBS/BAMS/BHMS/BDS) OR
- B.Tech Food Technology OR
- B.Voc Home Science/ Foods, Nutrition and Dietetics/Foods and Nutrition/Food Processing and Technology or its equivalent. OR
- B.Sc. Catering and Hotel Management or its equivalent. OR
- A graduate degree which includes at least four of the following subjects in the undergraduate programmes- Basic Nutrition, Biochemistry, Physiology, Food Science, Food processing/Food Preservation, Dietetics, Community Nutrition/Public Health Nutrition

- > Learners of any gender are eligible to apply for admission to the course.
- > Admission Criteria will be based on qualifying entrance examination.

The responsibility of checking the eligibility rests with the candidate. Please view the eligibility at https://nirmalaniketan.com/post-graduate

Number of Seats and Reservation Policy: 10 Seats

Subject to qualifying on the entrance procedures, following is the reservation policy applicable:

50% seats for Christian Minority = 5 seats (Admitted candidates will need to submit a <u>recent</u> baptism certificate at the time of admission)

20 % seats for Management = 2 seats

30% seats for Open Category = 3 seats

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Please note that there are three steps in the admission process:

- 1) Submitting the online **College Application Form** & online <u>payment of fees for application</u> on the **OnFees.com portal**:
 - a) Complete the Application Form.
 - b) Use the "Course Selection" option and select M.Sc. (Home Science) Foods, Nutrition and Dietetics.
 - c) If you are applying for multiple branches, please select each of these branches in the "Course Selection" option.
 - d) Next, go to "Payment Summary". The application form fee for <u>each</u> branch is ₹. 300 plus a service charge. Please make the payment using one of the following options: Net Banking, UPI, Debit Card, or Credit Card.
 - e) You will now be able to access the Payment History.
 - f) Lastly, please download the form.
- 2) Completing the University Pre-Enrolment Form on the University Portal (A separate pre enrollment form has to be filled for EACH of the MSc programmes that you are applying for). The University Pre-Enrolment process has not yet been activated by the University of Mumbai. Please keep checking the college website for updates regarding the University Pre-Enrolment process. Once it is activated, please be sure to complete the Pre-Enrolment Form separately for each of the branches to which you have applied and to download each of these Forms. The University Pre-Enrolment Form is required to be submitted to the college during the final stages of the admission process.
- 3) Final step to complete the application process:
 - <u>Upload the University Pre-Enrolment Form.</u> Admission will not be recognized without the Pre-Enrolment Form. It is mandatory to be submitted. In case it has not been released by the University of Mumbai, your form will still be accepted. The Pre-Enrolment Form can then be uploaded when it is available on the University Website. However, each PG programme applied for will have a separate Pre-Enrolment Form.
 - <u>Payment of Entrance Exam Fees</u> of ₹. 500/- for each course applied for MSc (Home Science) Foods, Nutrition and Dietetics, MSc (Home Science) Food Processing and Preservation, MSc (Home Science) Sports Nutrition, Postgraduate Diploma in Dietetics and Applied Nutrition, MSc (Home Science) Human Development and MSc (Home Science) Textile and Fashion Technology.
 - Those who have paid the entrance exam fees (₹. 500/-) will be included in the list of candidates eligible for the entrance exam. This list of candidates eligible for the entrance exam will be available on the 16th June 2025 on the college website.
 - The entrance exam is an eligibility exam (using your computer/mobile) on the college software. It will be conducted in the college premises. You will be seated in the college and will log on to the exam portal. There will be a practice mock online exam on 19th June 2025.
 - All the details regarding the entrance exam will be available on the college website by 16th June 2025. In addition, you will receive an email on your registered email id.

The admission will be based on the **qualifying entrance examination** conducted for eligible candidates. The syllabus for the entrance exam can be accessed here on this link <u>Syllabus-for-Entrance-Exam-for-MSc-FND</u>
