Instructions for Students:

- 1. Students to take note of the precise date, time and room for the examination given in the Timetable that is displayed on the notice board/website.
- 2. Students must report 15 minutes before the start of the test. Students on late entry will not be given extra time.
- 3. Entry to the examination room will be along with the Examination Supervisor.
- 4. Wear your College ID Card and carry pen, pencil, eraser and ruler. No pouches to be carried (No borrowing allowed).
- 5. Use blue/black ink pen only; rough work should be done on the same sheet.
- 6. Maintain **discipline** during the test; any malpractice will lead to disciplinary action as the UMIC Policy.
- 7. No gadgets (mobiles, smart watches, earphones) allowed in the exam hall.
- 8. Block Supervisors will check each student's Identity card & Hall Ticket before each examination. If any student is found to be without the Identity card or/& Hall Ticket, the name will be reported to the Examination Committee and a fine of Rs. 100/- will have to be paid by the student in the Accounts Office before the examination.
- 9. Students are expected to be present outside the examination room at least 30 mins prior to the commencement of the examination. If any student is found to have a mobile phone/any other digital device/written material during the examination with her, it is to be considered the use of unfair means with subsequent penalties. Moreover, a fine of Rs. 500/- has to be paid by the student.
- Students specially challenged or with learning disability, under the category of Divyangjan, requiring a writer etc., should take prior permission and should carry the valid original certificate in order to avail of special provisions during the examinations.
