3	Wear your <b>College ID Card</b> and carry your <b>Hall Ticket, pen, pencil, eraser and ruler. No pouches to be carried</b> (No borrowing allowed).
4	Use <b>blue/black ink pen</b> only; rough work should be done on the same sheet.
5	Maintain <b>discipline</b> during the test; any malpractice will lead to disciplinary action as the UMIC Policy.
6	No gadgets (mobiles, smart watches, earphones) allowed in the exam hall.
7	Block Supervisors will check each student's Identity card and Hall Ticket before each examination. If any student is found to be without the Identity card or Hall ticket, the name will be reported to the Examination Committee and a fine of Rs. 100/- will have to be paid by the student in the Accounts Office before the examination.
