**Instructions for Students:**

7. Use blue/black ink pen only; rough work should be done on the same sheet.
8. Maintain discipline during the examination; any malpractice will lead to disciplinary action as the UMIC Policy.
9. Students specially challenged or with learning disability, under the category of Divyangjan, requiring a writer etc., should take prior permission and should carry the valid original certificate in order to avail of special provisions during the examinations.
