

5. Use **blue/black ink pen** only; rough work should be done on the same sheet.
6. Maintain **discipline** during the test; any malpractice will lead to disciplinary action as the UMIC Policy.
7. No gadgets (mobiles, smart watches, earphones) allowed in the exam hall.
8. Block Supervisors will check each student's Identity card before each examination. If any student is found to be without the Identity card, the name will be reported to the Examination Committee and a fine of Rs. 100/- will have to be paid by the student in the Accounts Office before the examination.
9. If any student is found to have a mobile phone/any other digital device/written material during the examination with her, it is to be considered the use of unfair means with subsequent penalties. Moreover, a fine of Rs. 500/- has to be paid by the student.
10. Students specially challenged or with learning disability, under the category of Divyangjan, requiring a writer etc., should take prior permission and should carry the valid original certificate in order to avail of special provisions during the examinations.
