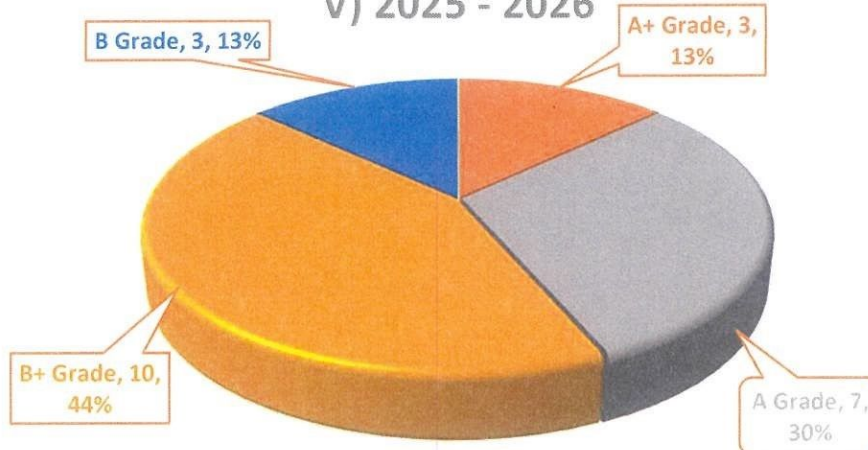

**RESULT ANALYSIS: T. Y. B. SC. HD (SEM-
V) 2025 - 2026**



The result analysis for T.Y.B.Sc. Semester V students specializing in Human Development for the academic year 2025–2026 reflects a commendable overall academic performance. A total of 27 students, all female, registered and appeared for the examination. The overall pass percentage stands at 85.19%, indicating a strong academic outcome for the batch. Among the students, none secured the highest 'O' grade; however, 3 students achieved an 'A+' grade, demonstrating high academic excellence. Additionally, 7 students obtained an 'A' grade, while the majority—10 students—secured a 'B+' grade, reflecting consistent and satisfactory performance. Furthermore, 3 students were awarded a 'B' grade. It is noteworthy that no students fell in the 'C' or 'D' grade categories. However, 4 students were unsuccessful and received an 'F' grade.

In terms of academic excellence, the top three rank holders are Ms. Dimple Lohani, who secured the highest CGPA of 9.50, followed by Ms. Hardika Adaniya with a CGPA of 9.20, and Ms. Aishwarya Agrawal with a CGPA of 9.15. The performance of the female students reflects dedication and consistent academic effort.
