All students of all departments are hereby informed that the **Student Council Elections for the Academic Year 2026–2027** will be held on **Friday, 4 September 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in the College Hall.**

The elections will be conducted for the posts of **College President, Secretary and Treasurer.**

Instructions for Voting

1. All students are required to participate in the election and cast their vote.
2. Voting will be conducted in the **College Hall between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.**
3. Students must carry their **College Identity Card or Fee Receipt** as proof of identity.
4. Each student will be provided with a ballot paper containing the names of the candidates contesting for the respective posts.
5. Students must **select ONLY ONE candidate for each post/column** on the ballot paper.
6. If more than one candidate is selected for the same post/column, the vote for that post will be considered **invalid**.
7. Students are advised to cast their vote during their break, or before or after their scheduled classes, to ensure that regular academic sessions are not disrupted.
8. Results will be declared on the 9th of September

All students are expected to participate responsibly in the election process and exercise their right to vote within the stipulated time.

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**IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES CONTESTING
THE STUDENT COUNCIL ELECTIONS**

Academic Year 2026–2027

All students contesting for the posts of **President, Secretary and Treasurer** are required to adhere to the following guidelines during the election and campaigning process:

1. Candidates may visit classrooms on **Tuesday, 1 September 2026 and Wednesday, 2 September 2026**, to introduce themselves and briefly address the students. The introduction must **not exceed two minutes per classroom**.
2. Candidates must conduct their campaign responsibly. **False claims, misleading information, inappropriate propaganda or unrealistic promises** are strictly prohibited.
3. Each candidate is permitted to display **one campaign poster with their photo (A3 or A4 size)** at the designated locations — the **Common Room Notice Board and/or the area near the back lift**. The photograph must clearly display the candidate's full face, with facial features visible and recognizable. Photographs in which the face is not clearly visible may not be accepted.
The poster must be approved and signed by Ms. Payal Maheshwari or Ms. Vibha Hasija before it is displayed. No unapproved poster will be permitted.
4. **Campaigning or promotion through social media is strictly prohibited.** Any candidate found engaging in social media campaigning or promotion will be liable for **disqualification from the election**.

All candidates are expected to maintain **decorum, fairness and discipline** throughout the election process and to strictly adhere to the above instructions.

Non-compliance with these guidelines may result in appropriate action, including disqualification, wherever applicable.
